AREA CODES

The Key to Faster Long Distance Service

The United States and Canada are divided into more than 100 telephone areas, each identified by a three-digit area code. See map.

How Area Codes Are Used

Use area codes to call from one telephone area to another, when the number you are calling has either two letters and five numerals or seven numerals. Do *not* use area codes when calling another telephone within the same telephone area.

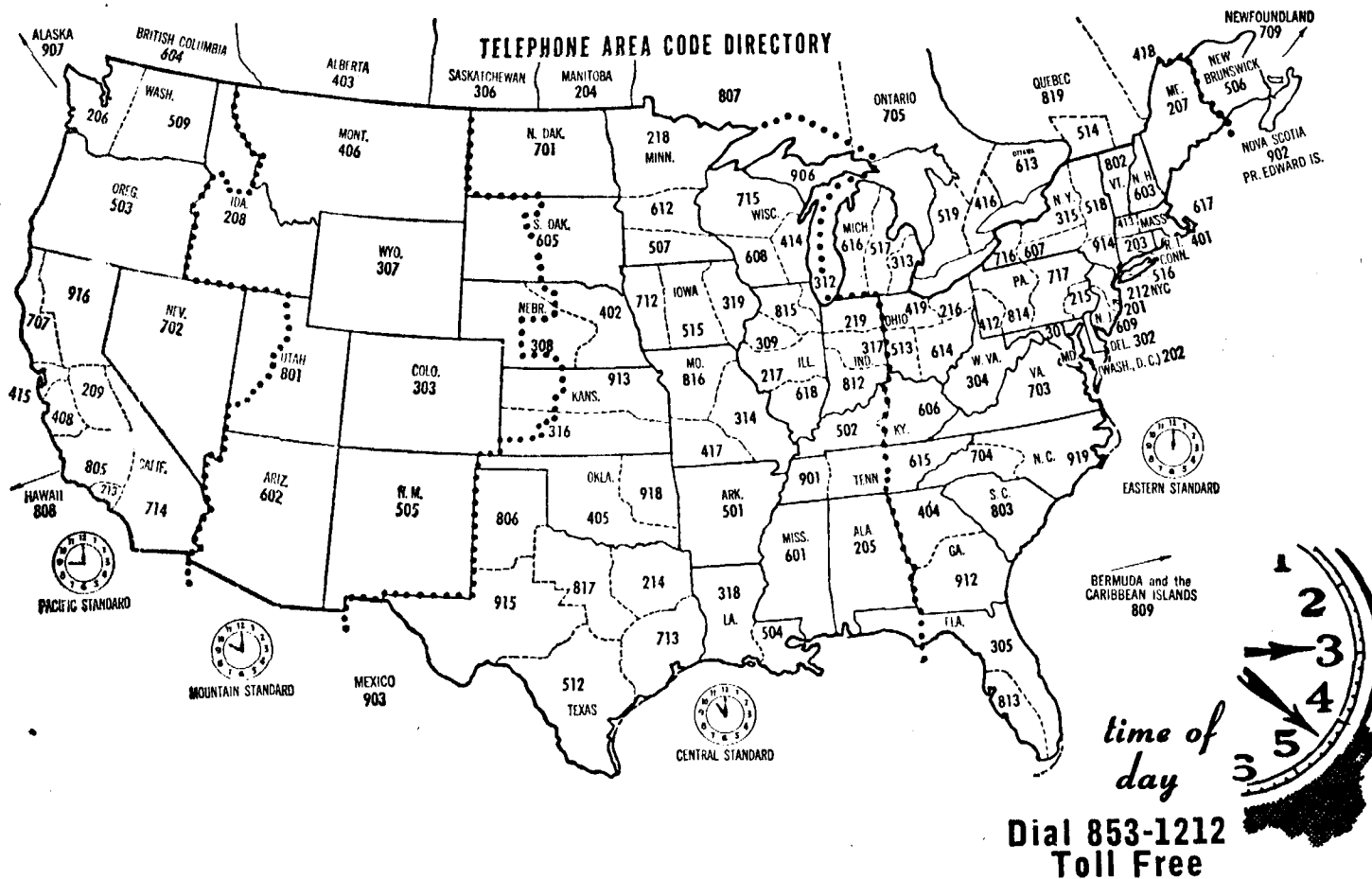
If You Place Calls with the Operator

Use the area code (if different from the one for the telephone you are using) to get your call through faster.

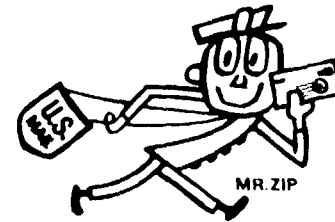
If you don't know the out-of-town number, DDD makes it possible to dial the Information Operator serving many distant places.

Long Distance Information

Can be reached without charge by Direct Distant Dialing. Dial as you would any DDD call using the access and area code, where appropriate, and 555-1212.



POSTAL ZIP CODE



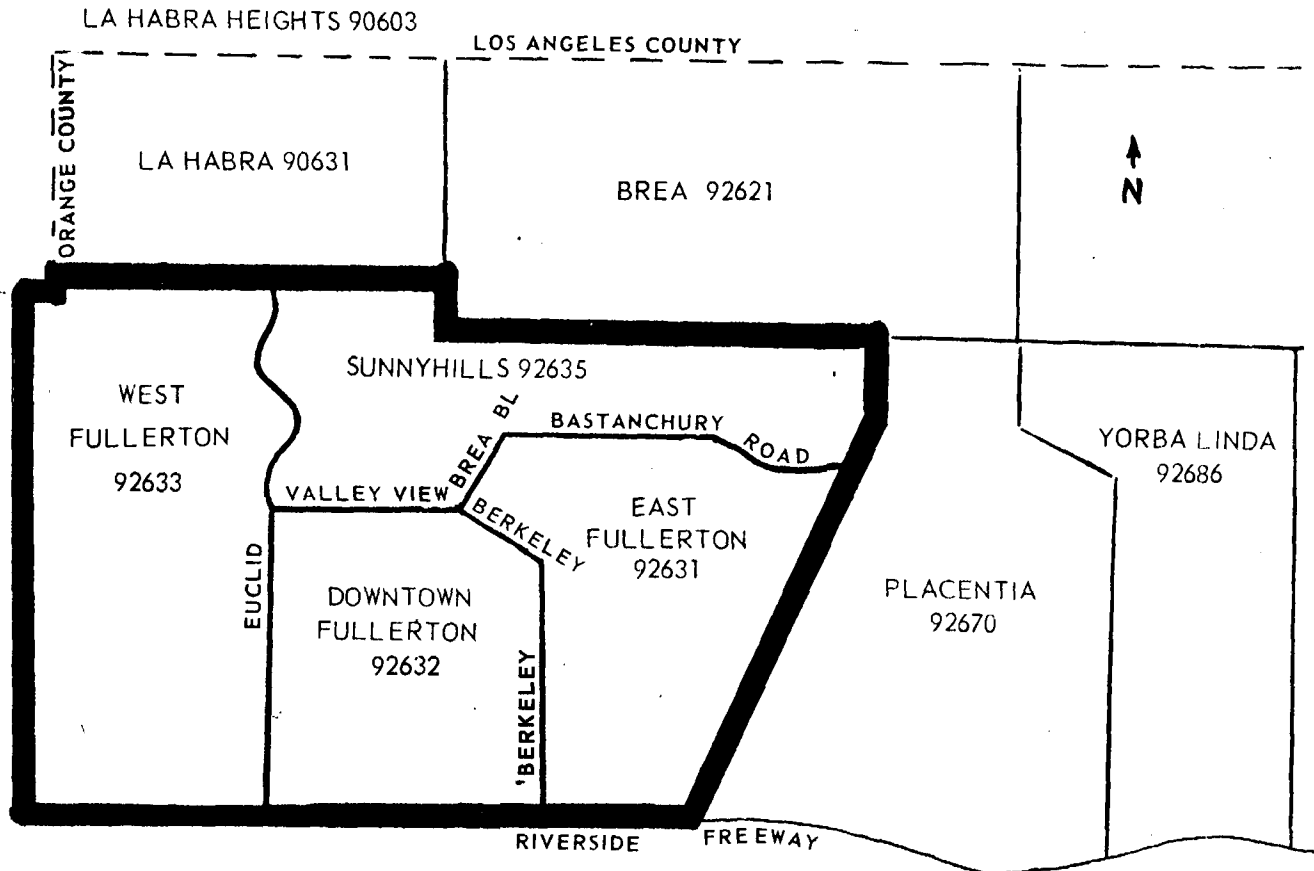

HOW TO USE

Zip Code is a five-digit code which identifies a delivery unit and associates that unit with a major post office through which mail is routed for delivery.

The first digit identifies one of ten large areas of the nation. The first three digits identify a major city or major distribution point. The five digits identify an individual post office, an area of a city, or other delivery unit.

Contact your local postmaster for instructions concerning the adding of ZIP Code numbers to your mailing list.

Mail formerly addressed using a Postal Zone number should now use a ZIP Code. For example:

Should be addressed:

Mr. John Doe
 2103 Washington Avenue
 Louisville, Ky. 40203

Your cooperation in using the ZIP Code is appreciated. For further information, call your postmaster.

Helpful Telephone Information

ANNOYANCE PHONE CALLS

The Telephone Company is concerned about obscene and harassing calls and is trying to stop them. You don't have to talk or listen to such calls—just hang up. If the calls persist, call your Service Representative at the Telephone Business Office. The Company wants to preserve your right to privacy.

TELEGRAMS BY TELEPHONE

You may telephone telegrams, cablegrams, or radiograms to the Western Union Telegraph Company and have the charges appear on your telephone bill. You may also telephone your Western Union telegrams from coin telephones, paying as you would for a telephone call.

AUTOMATIC ANSWERING TELEPHONES

Certain telephones are equipped with an automatic device, known as an Automatic Answering Set, which answers the telephone mechanically when no person is available to answer and then makes a recorded announcement.

If your call is answered by an Automatic Answering Set, listen carefully for the announcement which will be self-explanatory.

Some of these sets will also receive and record a message from the caller.

RECORDED TELEPHONE CONVERSATIONS ("Beep" tone)

If you hear a "beep" tone at fifteen-second intervals, your telephone conversation is being recorded by the person you are talking to. This signal is transmitted automatically whenever a recording machine is connected to the line. It is for your protection.

If you do not want a record made of what you are saying, ask the person with whom you're talking to disconnect the recording machine. The "beep" signal will stop when the recorder is disconnected.

TELEPHONE NUMBER ON STATIONERY

It's smart to make it easy for people to reach you. So why not include your telephone number on your stationery, statements and all advertising pieces? Show your Area Code, too—it helps distant parties call you faster.

Types of Long Distance Calls and How to Make Them

STATION-TO-STATION (DIRECT DIALING)

To make a station-to-station call to towns that can be dialed direct, dial 1, then area code if different from your own, then telephone number. Almost any town with 7-numeral or 2-letter, 5-digit phone numbers can be dialed direct. To make a station call to towns that can't be dialed direct, dial Operator.

Rates are lower than person-to-person. Charging begins when you are connected to the telephone number you called.

PERSON-TO-PERSON (DIAL OPERATOR)

Call person-to-person if you want to talk with a particular person, or a particular extension, department or office served by a switchboard. Charging begins when you are connected with the person, extension, department or office you called. Rates are higher than station-to-station.

COLLECT (DIAL OPERATOR)

Most calls can be made "collect" if the person you are calling agrees to pay the charge. If you want the call made collect, please be sure to tell the Operator when you give her the call.

OVERSEAS (DIAL OPERATOR)

To place calls or to obtain the rates for overseas calls, dial Operator and ask to be connected with the overseas operator handling calls to the desired ship or country.

CONFERENCE

You can talk with several people in different places at the same time. If you wish to do this, tell the Long Distance Operator you want to make a conference call.

HELPFUL INFORMATION ABOUT

Direct Distance Dialing

YOU WILL NOT BE CHARGED

- If you hang up before you dial the complete number.
- If the telephone you dial is busy or does not answer.
- If you call Directory Assistance (Information) in a distant city.

TO OBTAIN THE DISTANT AREA CODE

A map showing Area Codes appears on page 7. If the place you wish to call is not shown, dial Operator and ask for the Area Code.

IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE, DIAL OPERATOR

She will be glad to help you.

IF YOU REACH A WRONG NUMBER

Dial Operator immediately and tell her what happened so you will not be billed for the call.

ADDITIONAL DIRECTORIES

One directory was delivered free of charge to each house number. However, some persons require more than one directory. The Chamber of Commerce maintains a supply available free (one to a person).
